Travel Alcohol and Drug Policies

Off-Campus Travel Involving Students

The possession, use, or distribution of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs by students or employees is strictly prohibited on the property of the college, even if an activity does not involve students or employees. No college funds will be expended for the purchase of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs at any group activity taking place off college property or in another country (e.g. a reception or dinner in a culture with different laws and regulations on alcohol use and distribution). Students and sponsors are expected to follow these policy guidelines. (Southwestern College Policy Manual 2.12.8)

The Southwestern policy prohibits the procession and use of alcohol and illegal drugs on the residential campus. The travel policies are intended to be practical guidelines for sponsors and students who go abroad into lands where the laws and customs differ from those in the United States, the State of Kansas and from the policies of Southwestern College. The guidelines are not intended to violate or undermine the Southwestern College policy. They serve as a practical means of reinforcing the core values inherent to that policy in settings that are not controlled by the college, and to assist you in addressing your responsibilities.
