

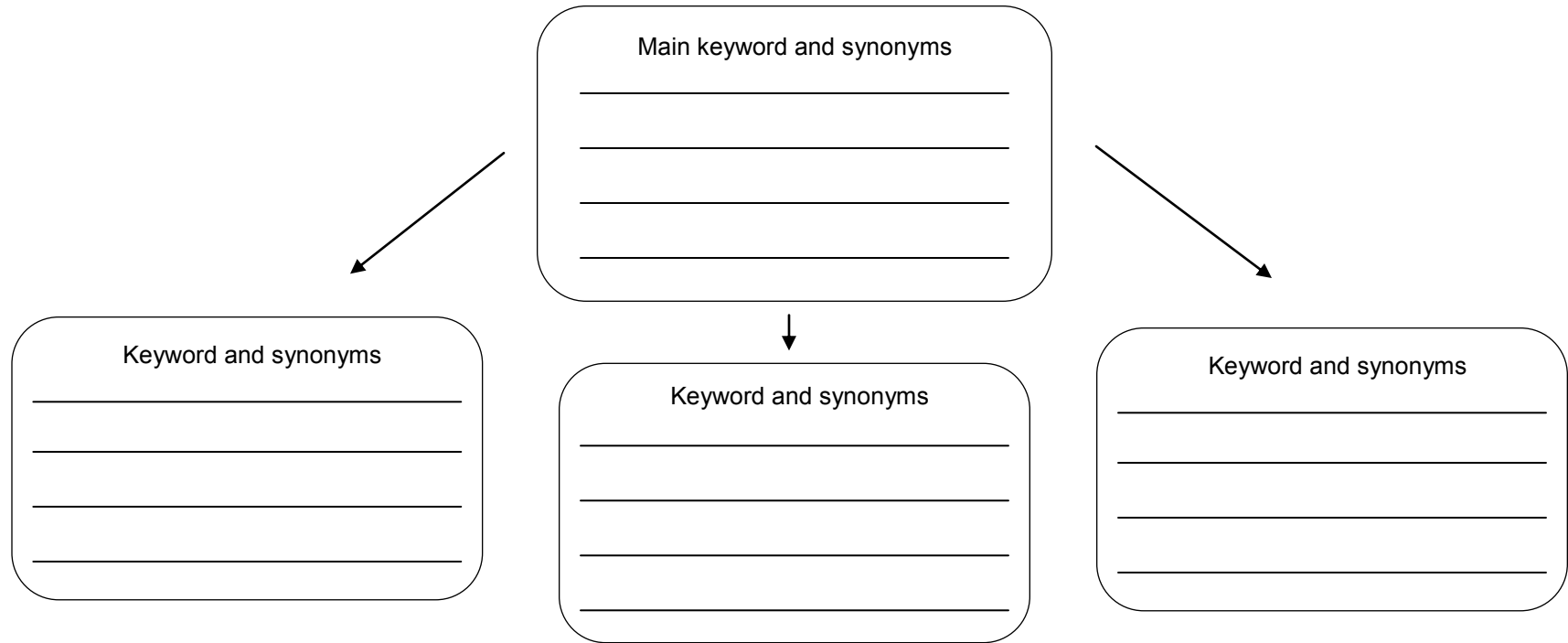
Make a Concept Map for Your Topic

This concept map will help you identify concepts or keywords to use as you search for information. It helps you identify what you already know about your topic and any gaps in your knowledge. This will make your search for information more effective. To complete this map, follow the steps below.

1. Write your topic sentence. Circle the keywords or keyword phrases.
