The purpose of this proposed action item is to establish the approval for automatic processing of College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) and DSST exams for Professional Studies learners in the area of electives, general education, and some direct course substitutions. The direct course substitutions will require a B- score instead of the C level score for passing. The worksheet identifies the specific exams, passing scores, and B- scores for direct course substitution where applicable.

These exams are currently accepted for general education and electives but not through automatic substitution. The addition of the B- standard and the automatic application of these exams for SCPS credit will benefit and expedite the processing of UG transcripts for PS learners. Currently the process is to complete substitution requests on a case by case basis for each individual learner once the transcript is received by the Registrar's office. We propose to establish this automatic processing to make what is already being done more efficient. In the area of Teacher Education, required courses already approved for acceptance are noted in the worksheet.

This proposal does not include any changes to the policy of accepting a maximum of 30 total credit hours combined in the categories of validation of credits by examination, credit for prior learning, and extra-institutional credit. (PS 2009-2010 UG Catalog, p. 17)
