



## Internship Opportunities at KSN

KSN Channel 3 in Wichita is currently accepting applications for college internships in our newsroom.

Our internship program is ongoing -- we will work with specific applicants to coordinate their academic schedule with ours. These are non-paid positions, and are offered only to students who require an internship for college credit. Students must be juniors, seniors or graduate level to apply.

The internship possibilities at KSN allow students to learn the everyday workings of a television and digital newsroom, and be involved in the behind-the-scenes process of how we put on live newscasts every day.

Students will have the opportunity to observe our assignment desk, producers, editors, photographers, reporters and anchors. They will be given the opportunity to shadow reporters and photographers to see how a story goes from concept to final product. They will see how the assignment desk, producers and directors work together to get a live newscast on the air. Those students displaying the necessary skills will help with the behind-the-scenes production of the stories/shows broadcast on KSN and ksn.com. At the conclusion of their internship, students should have a working knowledge of how to create TV news and should have a better understanding of which areas most interest them, as they continue their studies in college or prepare for professional work.

Students should include the semester they are applying for, the name of a faculty advisor and any requirements KSN must fulfill for proper academic credit. Students that are not U.S. citizens must have a valid student visa.
