## Church Matching Scholarship

Since 1972, Southwestern College has cooperated with churches of any denomination in the education of a student selected by that church. The college will match funds provided by the church, up to \$1,000 per year (\$500 per semester), with the Roy L. Smith Matching Scholarship. The scholarship is awarded for one school year at a time and is renewable upon the mutual consent of the church and Southwestern College.

We are aware of the variety of ways churches raise money – from pancake dinners, to endowments – to help students attend college. Funds must come from the local church or ideally from a standing scholarship committee.

### Eligibility

Students must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible for the Roy L. Smith Scholarship.

1. The student must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student.
2. The student must be selected by a church to receive the scholarship.
3. To renew this scholarship, the student must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
