Job Purpose: The cadaver laboratory assistant assists in the cadaver dissection procedures necessary for the Gross Human Anatomy course as well as helping supervise dissectors and providing teaching support for the Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 course.

Job Responsibilities:

- Assist Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 instructor in cadaver dissections.
- Assist in the organization and supervision of cadaver dissection team.
- Maintain human anatomy laboratory.
- Assist Human Anatomy and Physiology 2 instructor in teaching and grading duties for Human Anatomy and Physiology laboratory.

Qualifications:

- Must have previously completed either BIOL 242 or BIOL 342 unless the candidate has previous experience working with cadavers.
- Excellent fine motor skills.
