
Dillons Community Rewards Program

Fun Practice <u>Tips!</u>

These are a few tips to creating a meaningful practice session, as it is the best way to hone the craft of instrumental or vocal music.

- 1. Pick Music You Enjoy!
- Play with a Purpose perhaps your purpose might be to play as expressively as you can one day, as cleanly as you can the next day.
- Learn About your Music, you never know what might surprise you!
- Notice things you've already learned. While you work on a piece you enjoy, notice what elements make up the piece. Perhaps some passages work on the same elements that you would find addressed in a technical study.
