

Rotary Leadership Camp Rules

We want this week to be as fun as possible and to help make sure this happens we have enacted the following rules:

- Rooms are not co-ed, and girls are not allowed into guys' rooms/guys are not allowed in girls' rooms. There is no exception to this policy. Counselors may and WILL check rooms at night to make sure this policy is being followed.
- All students will observe quiet time at lights-out and will remain in their respective rooms unless an emergency arises.
- All furniture within the rooms must remain in the rooms throughout occupancy unless arrangements are made with the director.
- If there are any concerns/complaints about fellow campers and/or counselors, please direct these concerns to the directors.
- Treat others as you expect to be treated.
- Climbing on Fire ladders (interior rooms) will not be tolerated. If you are found to be participating in this activity, along with climbing out of any window, this may be grounds for dismissal from camp (except in case of emergency).
- Absolutely NO profanity, discrimination, fighting, sexual harassment, or throwing of objects of any kind indoors (including water balloons) will be tolerated and may be grounds for dismissal. If you feel someone has violated this rule, please contact one of the directors.
- Eating and Drinking in rooms is allowed. You will be expected to clean up any trash that may accumulate in your room before you are allowed to check-out.
- Cell phone use is prohibited during all activities. We recommend you just leave your cell phones in your rooms during the day. Cell phone use is allowed in the evening when none of the main activities are going on and during designated free times when in the dorm building. The only exception to this rule is for emergency purposes.
 - If parents or guardians need to contact their camper for any reason, they can do so through the directors who's phone numbers will be given out at check-in. Directors will have their phones on them at all times.
- **Policy on Alcohol and Drugs**

The possession, use, or distribution of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs by students or employees is strictly prohibited on the property of the college or as part of any college activity taking place off college property. Additionally, the possession, use, or distribution of alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs is strictly prohibited as part of any activity taking place on college property, even if that activity does not involve students or employees.

 - This includes vaping and juuling. Vapes, Juuls and other products like these will not be allowed on campus or during camp. The amount of nicotine or other chemicals they have does not matter. They are not allowed and we will confiscate them, only to be returned after camp.
- **Fire Hazards**

No smoking or tobacco use is permitted inside any campus building, including student rooms. Candles and incense are fire hazards and are not allowed. No open flame of any kind is allowed inside student rooms.

- Students must leave their rooms in the condition in which they were found at the beginning of occupancy.
- If any damages are found at check-out, the student(s) will be responsible for the cost of repairs.
- All Campers **MUST** check-out before they are allowed to leave camp on Saturday.
