Name of Position: Student Worker for Safety and Security Officer

Department: Security

Campus Location: All over campus and Southwestern College property

Length of Contract: Academic year 2023-2024

<u>Pay Rate:</u> \$10 an hour. This position requires the ability to work outside in all types of weather, stand and walk for long periods of time, traverse hills and navigate stairs, and operate with minimal supervision.

Job Purpose: This position supports the safety and security of all students, staff, faculty, and visitors to campus.

- Patrol the campus to monitor for safety
