

Southwestern College Employer Satisfaction Survey

2022-2023 Academic Year

The Southwestern College Employer Satisfaction Survey measures seven areas for the classroom teacher including: Managing the Classroom, Planning Units and Lessons, Understanding the Learner, Utilizing Methods of Teaching and Learning, Tracking Student Performance, Utilizing Technology, and Promoting Equity in the classroom.

Areas of strength include planning and implementing instruction, and understanding the learner as it relates to differentiating instruction. An area for improvement is managing the classroom. This data mirrors completer data when 40% indicated more instruction in classroom management and behavior is needed.

Focus group data from cooperating teachers and administrators also indicated a need for increased knowledge in behavior and classroom management. *Administrators noted post covid, the number of students exhibiting behavioral problems increased from before the pandemic.


All other areas indicate completers are accomplished apprentices.

Overall assessment of classroom management.



Overall assessment of ability to understand my learners:



Overall assessment of ability to understand my learners:



Overall assessment of of ability to utilize methods of teaching and learning.



Overall assessment of ability to track student performance.


